Map description:

Map extent will cover the major portions of Lake Placid and the Lake Placid NRA. Map file will consist of at least the following layers (final feature styles to be determined during project):

- 1) Lake polygon
- 2) Major rivers & streams (estimated 8-10 features)
- 3) Highways (3-4 features)
- 4) Major Roads and select minor streets
- 5) Major feature labels (e.g. Mtn. peaks, valleys, coves, bays, points and islands)
- 6) Park facilities (e.g. campgrounds, boats ramps, ranger stations)
- 7) Major trails (if applicable to the given scale)
- 8) Relief shading
- 9) Associated labeling and iconography

Estimate:
